Fishing - Wild Brown Trout Loch Fishing (from boats). Salmon and Seatrout (on river and loch). Tuition available by prior arrangement.

Game Shooting and Deer Stalking - Walked up and over Dogs Shooting for Flying and Ground Game. Stalking for Red, Roe and Sika Deer available by prior arrangement.

Golfing - There are 18-hole courses at Dornoch (Championship), Golspie, Brora and Tain, also a 9-hole course at Bonar Bridge. All within easy driving distance from Lairg (40 minutes maximum).

Hillwalking - Lairg is well situated offering easy access to the "Munro's and Corbet's" of the North West of Sutherland.
